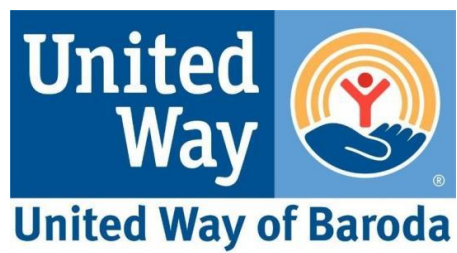

## 1. ABOUT UNITED WAY OF BARODA

United Way of Baroda stands as the pioneering United Way Chapter in India, founded in 1986. ## 2. BACKGROUND OF PROJECT

In today's knowledge-driven economy, **digital literacy and access to technology** are critical components of quality education. However, many rural and semi-urban schools still lack the infrastructure to provide interactive and technologically empowered learning experiences.

**Shri Vallabh Vidyamandir**, located at **40mt. Waghodia-Dabhoi Ring Road, Vadodara – 390025**, is a school that provides education from **Nursery to 12th Standard** and serves around **1,000 students**, primarily from low- and middle-income backgrounds. Despite the commitment of its faculty and management, the school faces infrastructural limitations in offering students access to modern educational tools.

While efforts have been made to set up a computer lab and upgrade learning resources, the school currently **does not have Smart Classroom facilities**. Under the **National Education Policy (NEP)**, technology-integrated teaching has become a necessity, particularly in enhancing students' conceptual understanding in subjects like science, mathematics, and languages.

To align with NEP goals and ensure inclusive access to digital education, the school is planning to install **at least 7 Smart Classrooms**. These will provide students with multimedia content, interactive lessons, audio-visual presentations, and access to online seminars and career development modules.

United Way of Baroda proposes to support the installation of **7 Smart Classrooms** at Shri Vallabh Vidyamandir to enable digital learning, reduce educational disparity, and prepare students for a future-ready world
